NEWS City Council wrestles over funding for new YMCA facility

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WELCOME TO DOWNEY

Downey is marking the 55th anniversary of The Carpenters signing their recording contract with A&M Records with festivities all this week.

Downey, the hometown of Richard and Karen Carpenter, is hosting a series of events honoring the three-time Grammy Award-winning brothersister duio.

Born in New Haven, Conn., the Carpenters relocated to Downey in 1963. Richard, displaying early musical talent, pursued piano lessons while Karen mastered the drums. Their signing with A&M Records in 1969 launched them to international stardom.

This week's anniversary celebration has attracted fans from around the globe, with attendees arriving in Downey from Canada, Australia, Europe, Mexico, Brazil, Sweden, Singapore and Japan. A four-day event is being organized and led by a committee of fans. Highlights include a meet and greet reception, historical tours, memorial tribute, sign unveiling, and musical legacy album listening experience.

"The Carpenters hold a special place in the hearts of Downey residents and music lovers worldwide," said Mayor Mario Trujillo. "We are honored to host this milestone anniversary celebration and pay tribute to Karen and Richard Carpenter's enduring legacy."

1792:

 Council members expressed a desire to help the YMCA but it's unclear how much.

DOWNEY – Tempers flared Tuesday over a City Council discussion on whether or not the city should give further financial contribution towards the new Kolar Family YMCA.

The YMCA is currently trying to raise \$20 million to build its new facility. Demolition of the existing building is scheduled to take place this year, with construction starting in 2025 and opening targeted for 2026.

"In the criminal justice system, it's always recommended that you also spend some funds, some of our limited funds, on crime prevention. Sometimes it's best to spend money up front, in crime prevention particularly "I think about where we are around our youth, to hopefully

supports crime prevention.

"We're not a small city people, we're the 10th largest city in the county of LA. A big city, 115,000 residents, no Boys and Girls Club, no youth center, no YMCA. What are for our youth? I think it's incumbent on us to spend in that area, to address public safety."

"It always amazes me how, yes, we must save for a rainy day, but then we have dilapidated, broken streets and sidewalks," Trujillo continued. "It's like the city is just saving for a future generation that's going to benefit from all that, while the residents are here now, hard-working residents; what about our quality of life, that we're here right now?

"We're so intent on saving money, I get it, but really? At the expense of kids and senior citizens? We control how much goes into reserves in the future. They're asking for a million dollars; I think they should get it."

> According to city officials, state law requires that the Planning Commission take action before the project would appear before the City Council for final approval.

> Guerra said that he had previously made everyone involved aware (including city staff and the other members of the planning commission) that he would not be attending the meeting, prior to his knowledge that the item would be on the agenda.



USC should let its valedictorian speak

USC's explanation as to why they canceled valedictorian Asna Tabassum's speech is disingenuous

Reasonable people can disagree about whether Asna Tabassum, who has expressed the view that the state of Israel should be destroyed, ought to be the University of Southern California's duly appointed commencement speaker.

There are prominent conservative voices such as Mary Katharine Ham, David Harsanyi, and Guy Benson, firm supporters of the Jewish state of Israel, all who say let her speak, in part because sunlight is the best disinfectant for ignorance or hate.

I agree with them.

But there are others who say calling for Israel's demise is just as disqualifying as the unrepentant use of a racial slur, and I can certainly understand that perspective as well.

But what we should all agree on, what is utterly obvious and staring us in the face, is that USC's explanation as to why they canceled the valedictorian's speech is a sack of disingenuous dunnage. And worse, it all but scapegoats Jews.

Here was the school's pathetic explanation, "The intensity of feelings, fueled by both social media and the ongoing conflict in the Middle East, has grown to include many voices outside of USC and has escalated to the point of creating substantial risks relating to security and disruption at commencement."

It is absolutely true that leftists have a long

track record of causing mayhem when speakers on campus say things they don't like, it is also true that more recently anti Israel protesters have done the same.

But what we do not have is any record of pro-Israel entities or individuals acting in such violent or destructive manners. Put simply, the threat USC is describing does not exist.

No Muslim students have had to hide in a library as protestors accost them as happened to Jewish students at Cooper Union, no roving bands of pro Israel activists are shutting down bridges, burning flags or chanting "death to America," or death to anything.

If the speaker were pro-Israel there might be a legitimate threat, but there is no threat here, which is exactly why USC won't specifically define it.

So what is the real reason for the cancellation? There are several plausible possibilities.

Maybe the president of USC didn't want to be dragged before Congress for promoting antisemitism, maybe there were concerns that the speech could offend attendees, or even worse, large donors to the institution.

But If USC believes that Tabassum's statements and ideology are not disqualifying then they have a responsibility to protect her free speech, on the other hand, if they do, or if they fear harm to the reputation or bottom line of the school then they have a responsibility to say that too.

In other words, if you're canceling the speech because of hateful statements then say so, don't blame imaginary violent Jews.

This cop out from USC is especially cowardly and damning because Tabassum's virulent anti-Israel rhetoric, far from being rare or obscure, is mirrored by members of Congress.

Just this week, 43 Democrats and Republican Thomas Massie voted against condemning the

phrase "From the River to the Sea," which can only mean the destruction of Israel and its total replacement by a Muslim Palestinian State.

Some of these members, such as Reps. Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez and Katie Porter were directly asked by Fox News if they condemned the chant "Death to America," or the burning of American flags and they declined to answer.

Obviously, the left wishes to excuse and even normalize this kind of dangerous, anti-American rhetoric, and that is exactly what USC is doing with its lies about why Tasabbum won't be taking to a lectern.

Just like AOC and Porter the university is refusing to comment when presented with the question of whether calling for the destruction of Israel is a disqualifying statement for a commencement speaker.

There is a long history of antisemitism being swept under the rug across the globe, it is an uncomfortable issue that people and institutions find ways to ignore.

That approach doesn't generally end well.

Whether calling for the destruction of Israel is an antisemitic statement that should bar a person from an honor such as valedictorian is a reasonable argument, in fact, just the kind of debate that colleges and universities are meant to foster.

Instead, USC has simply decided to punt on the question, leaving the completely false impression that Tabassum has been canceled by threats from conservatives or Zionists.

For my part, I say, let her give the speech, but what is more important is for the University of Southern California to explain exactly why that isn't happening.

To beat Trump, President Biden must act on immigration

The waves of recent migrants have produced problems as anyone on the ground can confirm,

Bill Maher recently said on his show that the 2024 election was going to be fought over two issues: immigration and abortion. The party that best navigates these cultural battlefields is likely to prevail in November.

Each party has an advantage, the Democrats on abortion and the Republicans on immigration. Roe v Wade, the landmark 1973 Supreme Court decision that legalized abortion, energized generations of conservative voters who felt deeply on the issue but were also outraged that courts had taken the question out of the democratic process.

Now, it's abortion rights voters who are energized, fueled by states like Arizona that are putting in place draconian restrictions on abortion. With the margins small in many swing states, abortion could be the issue that brings out suburban women, who could tilt those states blue in November.

On the other hand, the Republican Party is now led by former President Donald Trump, who —



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a political career within the Republican Party, at which point he reversed course fully.

Now that he sees it is politically problematic, he is shifting his stance once again. He has criticized Arizona's abortion ban and has pledged not to sign a national abortion ban if re-elected.

It might seem hard for him to backtrack; he has loudly taken credit for the repeal of Roe v. Wade and touted his anti-abortion credentials. But Trump seems able to say anything, and even do anything, without losing the cult-like following he has with Republican voters. He can appeal to the middle ground, certain that his base will stay with him.

President Joe Biden, on the other hand, does not have the fanatical following that Trump does. He has constructed a coalition carefully appealing to different groups with specific policies. If he loses one of those groups, his team fears that the math will not add up come Election Day.

But he needs to risk it and get tougher on immigration. It has become a proxy for all kinds of issues where people feel that elites simply don't get the concerns of average people. And the concern is rooted in real facts on the ground.

The US has taken in huge numbers of immigrants over the last five decades. In 1970, foreign-born people made up 5.7% of the country. As of 2020, that number was 15.3%. And it's not just America. In Sweden, that number went from 6.6% in 1970 to 19.8% in 2020; in the UK, from 5.3% to 13.8%. As I note in my new book, "Age of Revolutions," the Western world has seen a wave of unprecedented migration. Considering the numbers and the cultural diversity of the immigrants, people have been remarkably tolerant.

In both the EU and the United States, gangs and cartels have recognized that they can game the asylum system by bringing in migrants who are moving for economic reasons but who apply for asylum, claiming that they are being persecuted at home — and thus get the right to stay, have legal hearings and eventually work. Last fiscal year, nearly a million people applied for asylum in the US. In the EU last year, that number was more than 1.1 million.







What's the difference between antiperspirants and deodorants? Are they safe?

We use deodorants and antiperspirants because of moisture and odor. Sweat is the body's cooling mechanism, and our armpits



areas of the body. Sweat itself doesn't have a strong

odor, but it is broken down by bacteria, which then produce an odor. The moist warmth of the armpit is an ideal environment for bacteria.

Antiperspirants and deodorants work in different ways to reduce body odor. Deodorants work to eliminate armpit odor, but not sweat. Antiperspirants reduce sweat. Deodorants are typically alcohol-based, and increase skin acidity, which makes the skin less attractive to bacteria. They also contain perfume to mask odor. The Food and Drug Administration considers deodorants to be a cosmetic product, while antiperspirants are treated as a drug.

Antiperspirants usually include aluminum-based compounds that reduce the amount of perspiration by temporarily blocking sweat pores. Are there risks associated with using them?

A few studies have theorized that if the skin absorbs these aluminumbased compounds, the estrogen receptors of breast cells might be affected, leading to an increased risk of breast cancer. It has been noted that most breast cancers develop in the upper outer portion of the breast, which is the area closest to the armpit, where antiperspirant is applied. However, multiple studies have found that cancer tissue in those who use antiperspirants does not appear to have a higher concentration of aluminum, and at this time, the American Cancer Society has found no link between cancer and the aluminum in antiperspirants.

Studies from the 1960's found high levels of aluminum in the brains of those suffering from Alzheimer's disease. That research called into question the safety of everyday household items such as aluminum cans, antacids...and antiperspirants. Subsequent studies did not support those concerns, and any connection between aluminum and Alzheimer's disease has since been disproved.

• An FDA warning appears on antiperspirant labels, which states: "Ask a doctor before use if you have kidney disease." Experts believe that it is almost impossible to absorb enough aluminum through the skin to fragrances are not regulated.

harm the kidneys. However, because a poorly functioning kidney is not able to remove aluminum, those with chronic kidney disease should indeed avoid antiperspirants.

What about deodorant? (Note, by the way, that most antiperspirants also contain deodorant.) Deodorants do indeed contain chemicals which show up in fat cells.

Parabens are a group of chemicals used as preservatives. Although it's possible that these chemicals may interfere with the way the body produces and regulates estrogens, the American Cancer Society and the National Cancer Institute say that there is no conclusive evidence linking them to any significant problems.

Triclosan prevents bacterial contamination and kills bacteria on the skin. While some research points to a potential problem among amphibians and fish, there is no evidence that triclosan poses any problem in humans.

Phthalates help deodorant and other cosmetics stick to the skin. While it is possible that they may have an effect on the way the body produces and uses testosterone, there is no significant evidence of harm seen in studies to date.

There are possible issues with fragrances. Fragrances are formulated from a wide variety of chemicals, and certain individuals might react to any one of these chemicals. The specific ingredients in

My conclusions?

While the major scientific professional organizations we rely on state that no harmful effects have been shown, we all can decide for ourselves. The only sure strategy to avoiding any potential harm is to stop using these products, choosing only natural products that are free of phthalate, paraben, triclosan, and fragrance. Personally, these issues do not unduly concern me.



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
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
