Voters choose familiar names

Rep. Lucille Roybal-Allard, Assemblymember Cristina Garcia and Supervisor Janice Hahn are all re-elected.

DOWNEY - Downey residents won't see any change in their representation in Sacramento or Washington, D.C.

Congresswoman Lucille Roybal-Allard, Assemblymember Cristina García and L.A. County Supervisor Janice Hahn were all easily re-elected Tuesday.

As of Thursday morning, Roybal-Allard had collected 23,956 votes to beat out five challengers in Congress' 40th District: Republican C. Antonio Delgado (6,869), Democrat David John Sanchez (6,860), Democrat Anthony Felix Jr. (6,118), Green Party candidate Rodolfo Cortes Barragan (3,227) and American Independent candidate Michael Graham Jr. (1,321).

Garcia had only one opponent in her quest for re-election, Green Party candidate Margaret Villa

Garcia tallied 34,216 votes to Villa's 10,053.

Hahn also had a single opponent in the race for the Fourth District seat of the L.A. County Board of Supervisors

Hahn netted 171,207 votes to Desiree Washington's 54,541.

Lacey holds lead in DA race

LOS ANGELES - Los Angeles District Attorney Jackie Lacey took a commanding early lead against two criminal justice reformers looking to unseat the two-term career prosecutor but she still may face a November runoff.

Lacey had 50.14% of the vote Thursday morning with about 500,000 ballots still to be counted.

She was trailed by former San Francisco District Attorney George Gascon with 27.22% and ex-public defender Rachel Rossi's 22.6%.

The candidate with more than 50% of votes in the nonpartisan contest wins.

If no one gets a majority, the top two will face a runoff in November.

The winner will oversee the largest prosecutor's office in the U.S., with nearly 1,000 lawyers, and a territory that covers the nation's second-largest city and 10 million residents across the sprawling county.

The event is called the Walk for Water and it's happening this Saturday, March 7, from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. on the Downey High School track.

"Our goal is to have the whole city of Downey walking around the high school track, which means we could fund two wells and bring clean drinking water to people in the developing world from that one day," said Diana Mae Baliscao, the club's president and a senior at Downey High School. "Think about it. Three miles is the average women and children walk for water in the developing world just to fetch water that is not even clean, we get to experience walking in their shoes at our walk."

This inspired group of Downey students have been planning and coordinating the Walk for water since the beginning of the school year and have partnered with different schools not only in Downey Unified School District but all over the region. Many parents, teachers, and students will be bused in to attend the Walk for Water.

The Challenge

annual Walk for Water will be held at Allen Layne Stadium, in Downey High School. Those who attend the event will have the opportunity to walk 12 laps around the track or less carrying water in either water gallons or jerry cans depending on the participant's ability.

All ages young and old will be able to walk in the shoes of women and children who suffer from water scarcity. Most importantly, participants will be part of raising \$24,000 to build two wells in developing countries.

The event will also have fun activities for children, informational booths and water awareness exhibits to bring awareness to the global water crisis.

The group aims to bring awareness to how many people around the world don't have clean water. According to a Downey High School's 2nd report from the World Health Organization and UNICEF, 844

million people don't have access to safe water. That's one of the major factors for diarrhea, which kills 801,000 children each year, says the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.

"We are inspired to do this walk because of the staggering number of people who lack access to clean water, a resource we in the United States don't think twice about," said Jordan Guerrero, senior at Downey High School.

The cost to participate in the Walk for Water is \$25 for adults and \$10 for DUSD stuents with ID. Kids ages 4 and younger are free.

Archuleta named Legislator of the Year

DOWNEY - State Sen. Bob Archuleta has been named Legislator of the Year for 2019 by the California State Commanders Veterans Council.

The award is given in recognition for leadership and efforts on behalf of California's veterans, active duty military, reserves, and the California National Guard.

Archuleta, who represents Downey in the state legislature, will be presented the award at the state Capitol on April 22.

"It is an honor for me to receive this recognition from the California State Commanders Veterans Council. I will continue to work with all veterans and active military in the state of California to represent them to the best of my ability," Archuleta said. "I will continue working with my colleagues and the governor's office on veterans' homelessness, as well as issues pertaining to our active military and our 22 armed force bases in California."

Archuleta authored Senate Bill 289 in 2019, which was signed by Gov. Gavin Newsom. SB 289 allows active duty service members, upon receiving orders to transfer out of state, to maintain their eligibility status or their place on the waiting list for services.

This bill would also allow military personnel and their families to apply for the Medicaid HCBS waiver program when they receive notification of their pending transfer into the state.

Elected in 2018, Archuleta is an Army veteran and was a combat paratrooper with the 82nd Airborne Division. He is the current Chair of the Senate Committee on Veterans Affairs.

"When Senator Archuleta was appointed as the Chairman of Senate Committee on Veterans Affairs, we instinctively knew he would be the right person for the job," said Frederick Romero, chairman of the California State Commanders Veterans Council. "He has captivated us with his intimate knowledge, and unique ability to understand and relate to the active duty military and California veterans. He has also shown, through action in his first year, his desire to tackle the tough issues such as the California Veterans Homes and the Disabled Veterans Business Enterprise program."

Archuleta served as a Presidential Appointee under then-President Barack Obama as the first Mexican American to be appointed to the Board of Visitors to the United States Military Academy at West Point, which inquires into the morale, discipline, curriculum, and other matters relating to the academy, and he was immediately elected as co-chair. He also served on the Los Angeles County Military Veteran Affairs Commission and the United States Army Advisory Board for Military Recruitment.

The California State Commanders Veterans Council is a group of 20 veterans service organizations and other military service-related organizations, whose mission is to evaluate pending state legislation affecting California's veterans, whether active, reserve, National



Guard, or retired. The Council was founded in 1966 and meets regularly to coordinate legislative strategies to advance veterans issues at the state level.

Downey group honors women leaders



Garcia wants more oversight of Contract Cities

DOWNEY - After several reports of inappropriate behavior at events sponsored by the California Contract Cities Association, Assemblymember Cristina Garcia has introduced legislation that will "provide accountability and transparency of taxpayer dollars that flow to associations of local agencies or districts."

"Taxpayers expect their money to be used responsibly and there to be transparency, at the state level and in their local governments. This should extend to these local government lobbying organizations." Continues Garcia, "These groups are extensions of governments and therefore taxpayers themselves – who don't expect governmental activities to result in drunken brawls and mismanagement of funds."

Contract Cities came under scrutiny last May after a fist-fight between two city officials left one person unconscious.

The fight occurred around 12:30 a.m., after the first day of business at the Annual Municipal Seminar, held at the Renaissance Indian Wells Resort & Spa. The meeting agenda included panels on such issues as homelessness, active shooters and government ethics.

There also was plenty of time for relaxation and fun on the taxpayers' dime.

A golf tournament was played before official business started and conference attendees received a welcome bag with a bottle of wine, corkscrew and several tickets for free alcoholic drinks at conferencesponsored events.

This incident with the mismanagement of funds and inappropriate behavior at the Contract Cities event is not unique. Several years ago, the executive director of the California School Boards Association (CSBA) resigned from his position after it was reported that he used a CSBA-issued credit card to get \$11,000 in cash from area casinos. Current law does not require financial oversight of these agencies, which could potentially allow taxpayer dollars to be funneled to personal bank accounts or to throw extravagant parties in lavish hotels.

"For local governments and school boards to be bankrolling parties and padding personal bank accounts is a slap in the face to California's residents, who are often working class and struggling to make ends meet," continued Garcia.

AB 2452 will expand on Assembly Bill 187 (Lara, 2011), which established the High-Risk Local Government Agency program within the State Auditor's office to allow audits on local government associations that receive taxpayer dollars to operate.

Currently, the state does not have any direct oversight of the use of taxpayer dollars in local government associations. Should this legislation pass, the State Auditor would have the ability to identify waste, fraud, abuse or mismanagement.

"I look forward to working with all stakeholders to create good government and the responsible use of our taxpayer dollars for California's residents," said Garcia.



The best treatment for coronavirus is paid sick leave

The Federal Reserve did what it could Tuesday to offset the growing economic impact of the coronavirus by announcing a supersize reduction in its benchmark interest rate — the first time the Fed has acted between its regularly scheduled meetings since the financial crisis in 2008.

But the Fed is ill equipped to limit the effect of a global pandemic alone. Lower interest rates may eventually soothe financial markets and help to hold down borrowing costs, but the Fed can't speed the reopening of Chinese factories or reverse Facebook's decision to cancel an annual developers conference that last year brought 5,000 visitors to San Francisco.

"A rate cut will not reduce the rate of infection. It won't fix a broken supply chain. We get that," Jerome H. Powell, the Fed's chairman, conceded at a news conference on Tuesday.

The real work falls on the rest of the government. The first step should have been simple: ensuring that testing for the coronavirus was readily available and, better yet, free. But even after weeks of lead time for the virus's inevitable arrival, access to testing remains woefully inadequate as the domestic death toll rose to nine on Tuesday

At this point, the crisis also demands unorthodox solutions. To restrict the spread of the coronavirus, the government needs to put limits on commerce. The best way to protect people, and the economy, is to limit economic activity. That is an unfortunate but inescapable truth. Public health officials will need to impose quarantines, businesses will need to cancel meetings. And most of all, the problem now and going forward is making sure that sick workers stay home. That means not forcing employees to choose

between penury and working while coughing.

Congress can help by mandating that workers receive paid time off if they fall ill, or if they need to care for an ailing family member. Such a policy is necessary both to impede the spread of the virus and its economic harm. Roughly one-quarter of workers in the private sector — about 32 million people — are not entitled to any paid sick days. Absent legislation, they face a choice between endangering the health of co-workers and customers and calling in sick and losing their wages and perhaps also their jobs.

The current system is practically devised to spread infectious disease. Among the people least likely to have paid sick days, and therefore most likely to work through illness, are low-wage service workers like restaurant employees and home health care aides. (Those workers also are less likely to have health insurance, which compounds the problem.)

Most developed nations require employers to provide some form of paid sick leave, and the United States should do so, too. Some tates already mandate sick leave, and a recent study found that the adoption of such laws reduced cases of influenza by 11 percent in their first year. Whatever the course of the coronavirus, mandatory sick leave for American workers would improve the lives of families and insulate the economy against pandemics.

If Congress cannot bring itself to do the right thing, however, it still could help by mandating sick leave specifically for this coronavirus. A 2013 study of workers in Allegheny County, Pa., estimated that allowing them to take up to two paid "flu days" would have reduced workplace transmission of the flu by roughly 39 percent.

Employers sometimes argue that sick leave policies encourage malingering. But studies show that even accounting for workers who

play hooky, society still benefits.

The government could defray the cost of emergency sick leave for employers, for example by allowing businesses to claim a onetime tax credit. There is also a good case for providing broader help, particularly to smaller companies that cannot easily weather a loss of revenue.

The Italian government, for example, announced Sunday that would issue tax credits to businesses that reported declines in revenue of 25 percent or more — in effect shifting the losses from private balance sheets to the government's balance sheet.

Also seeking to help smaller businesses, the Chinese government has announced that banks can defer the receipt of loan payments from smaller companies that were due during the first half of the year without being required to report such loan payments as overdue. In hard-hit Hubei province, the leniency applies to larger companies, too

The Trump administration so far has shown little interest in tailored responses. President Trump reacted to the Fed's announcement by demanding further rate cuts. He has insisted that the United States should have the world's lowest interest rates; the European Central Bank's benchmark rate currently sits below zero, at -0.5 percent.

Mr. Trump also has said that Congress should pass a payroll tax cut.

If the federal government fails to contain the spread of the coronavirus, and the economic outlook darkens, such a broad-based stimulus may well become necessary. But targeted policies - like sick days — are likely to remain the most effective form of response.
