Gil Legaspi enters council race

■ An LAPD officer and civic volunteer, Gil Legaspi said he is looking to restore accountability to the City Council.

DOWNEY – Police officer and commercial real estate broker Gil Contreras Legaspi has declared his candidacy for Downey City Council, seeking to fill the vacant District 3 seat.

Legaspi, 48, said his priorities are to decrease crime by hiring more police officers and to expand the city's initiatives to address homelessness.

If elected, Legaspi said he would work to cut "excess red tape at city hall" to help businesses, and to increase transparency between Downey residents and local government.

He is also the only current bilingual candidate.

"We need to invest in Kutzke and Dianna Smith technology to streamline things and bring transparency that is fiscally responsible," Legaspi said.

Legaspi is involved extensively in the Downey community. He is a member of the Rotary Club of Downey, an ambassador with the Downey Chamber of Commerce, and a member of Gangs Out of Downey.

ON THIS DAY

1613: During a performance of William Shakespeare's Henry VIII, the famous Globe Theatre in Londonwas destroyed within an hour after its thatch was accidentally set aflame by a cannon marking the king's entrance onstage.

1767: Parliament passed the Townshend Revenue Act, sponsored by British Chancellor of the Exchequer Charles Townshend, which imposed on colonists in British America an import tax on tea and other goods and thus brought some colonists one step closer to revolution.

1861: English poet Elizabeth Barrett Browning, famous for her Sonnets from the Portuguese, died at age 55 from a severe chill.

Although many are taking a much-deserved break, many in Downey Unified continue to work through the summer, providing valuable programs and preparing for the upcoming school year. Our summer enrichment programs are in its third week and offering valuable programs for those students opting to participate. All Downey Unified's middle and high schools offer summer school classes and five of our elementary campuses provide a great STEAMworks (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Math) program centered around the goal of building broader education to our students.

Although other districts offer summer school to their students, I can proudly say that very few (if any) offer a STEAM based program for elementary school students like Downey Unified. With so many amazing enrichment opportunities, we

are proud that over 6,500 of our students are participating in our summer programs from TK through 12th grade.

As we head further into summer, I also want to take this time to congratulate our almost 2,000 high school graduates that celebrated commencement at the beginning of June. We had 20 students who graduated from our Virtual Academy, over half of these graduates were honored for maintaining a 3.0 or better GPA and eight were distinguished as Golden State Seal Honorees; 947 Downey Vikings, 37 who finished the 2022-23 school year with a 4.5 GPA or higher; 739 Warren Bears, 27 proudly finishing with a 4.5 GPA or higher and 230 dedicated Columbus Lions.

Downey Unified's vision is to have our students graduate college and career ready, globally competitive, and citizens of strong character, and I know the rigorous education they have experienced during their time with us has provided them with the tools needed to push them toward success in their futures; whether that means going to college or directly into the workforce or the military.





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Lack of affordable housing fueling homelessness crisis, study finds

The UC study discovered that most adults living on the streets became homeless due to rising costs in housing.

SACRAMENTO California's homelessness crisis is a homegrown problem that is deepening amid a shortage of affordable housing and emergency shelter, and it's often the brutal conditions of living on the street that trigger behavioral health problems, such as depression and anxiety, researchers found in a comprehensive study on homelessness.

The new findings by leading researchers at the University of California show that at least 90% of adults who are experiencing homelessness in the state became homeless while living in California due primarily to the dire lack of affordable housing.

"This idea that homeless people are rushing into California is just not true," said Margot Kushel, a physician who treats homeless people and the lead investigator of the study for the UC-San Francisco Benioff Homelessness and Housing state's homelessness crisis, said point to the increasing demands Initiative. "There's so much myth-making around this magnet theory that people who are homeless flock to California, but this is our own problem."

"These are our own policies," Kushel added, referring to the state and federal governments. "We did this to people."

An estimated 172,000 people are homeless in California, the largest homeless population of any state in the U.S. and 30% of the nation's total, even though California has just 12% of the population. Researchers believe the way the state measures homelessness, though important, represents an undercount because

Researchers believe many unhoused people encountered have violence, contributing to the crisis: 72% reported physical violence in their lifetime and 24% said they had experienced sexual violence. Sexual violence was more common among women and transgender or nonbinary individuals.

The homeless population is aging; 47% of all adults surveyed were 50 or older. And Black and Native Americans are disproportionately homeless. For example, just 6% of the state's population is Black, yet 26% of homeless people surveyed identified as Black.

The findings show the limits of California's unprecedented spending to combat its homelessness crisis. Newsom's administration has poured more than \$20 billion into the crisis since he took office in 2019, much of that distributed to local by KFF Health News, which governments to provide services and build housing.



> Forced displacement, the report found, and confiscation of belongings when clearing encampments can hurt the state's ability to find housing for people, Kushel said.

> "It sometimes feels like one part of government is working against the other part," she said. "We're frantically trying to get people their documents so they can move into housing, and then somebody else throws it all away. That's not helpful."



I understand why Lizzo took a beat from Twitter.

Last month, the Emmy- and Grammy-winning multihyphenate artist — a classically trained, flute-playing rapper, singer, songwriter, actress and fashion mogul — was under attack (again!) from internet trolls bombarding her with vicious messages about her weight. This time, it got so bad that she locked down her Twitter account, writing, "Y'all don't know how close I be to giving up on everyone and quitting.

Lizzo embraces inclusivity for everyone who has a body. She chants the mantra of body positivity for all humans, not just the fat ones. Her songs, including "Good as Hell" and "Truth Hurts," have resonated with millions of people as anthems of empowerment and self-acceptance. She lives freely and unapologetically, whether twerking on the beach with her besties or modeling stylish crop tops from her shapewear brand Yitty.

But for years, Lizzo has faced backlash from people made uncomfortable by her unabashed acceptance of herself — who would rather see her concealed in oversize cardigans and potato sacks

But government isn't Santa Claus. Government is force.


Most every law takes away a little of our money or freedom or both

The Heritage Foundation ranks economic freedom across the globe. The United States once ranked No. 4 in the world, but we've been in decline. This year, as my new video explains, we're 25th.

'If you care about living a prosperous life, you should care about what government economic policies are," says The Heritage Foundation's Derrick Morgan.

The foundation ranks countries' economic freedom based on things like rule of law, regulatory efficiency, open markets, fiscal health. etc.

The big reason the USA fell in the rankings is that Congress spends so much more money than government can squeeze out of us in taxes.

In addition, politicians ban some of our choices, like future natural gas hookups and gas-powered cars. Many want to ban contraception, TikTok, guns. And on top of that, America's tobacco sales, junk food sales, night clubs, hookah lounges, bureaucrats add thousands of regulations, most of which restrict individual freedom.

The world's least free countries have even more smothering governments. India ranks toward the bottom of the freedom list because Indian bureaucrats are empowered to decide whether entrepreneurs may try something new. Investors must get up to 70 different approvals. No wonder India stays poor.

It could be worse. The most repressed people in the world are trapped in countries at the bottom of the freedom list: Sudan, 'enezuela, Cuba and, of course, North Korea.

Hong Kong was a great example of how economic freedom makes life better. In just 30 years, people there moved from poverty to prosperity. It happened because Hong Kong's British rulers enforced rule of law but put few obstacles in the way of trying new things. That allowed free people in Hong Kong to get rich and put Hong Kong at the top of many freedom rankings.

Then the British gave Hong Kong back to China. China promised to respect Hong Kong's open society, but a few years ago, China turned Hong Kong into another Chinese police state.

So Heritage dropped Hong Kong from its list. "We got to the point where we could no longer consider them separate from Communist China, sadly," says Morgan.

The freest countries on Heritage's list are Taiwan, Ireland, Switzerland and Singapore.

But wait! Singapore doesn't have free speech. You can't criticize politicians or assemble without a police permit. They recently hanged some people for selling marijuana.

"Would you want to live in Singapore?" I ask Morgan.

"Your point is a good one," he responds. "This isn't a measure of freedom overall. It's a measure of economic freedom. Other not many. freedoms are important, religious freedom ... First Amendment freedom."

The Cato Institute's Human Freedom Index, which ranks both economic and personal freedom, lists Switzerland, New Zealand, Estonia and Denmark as the freest countries. Singapore ranks 44th. America 23rd.

"Our point," explains Morgan, "is really to have a data longevity to look at. Does economic freedom over time lead to freer, more prosperous, healthier and cleaner environments? It does."

That's something to remember next time politicians take away your choices or print more money.

"They're going to offer you free stuff," says Morgan. "It's all going to sound good ... but their policies are in all likelihood going to make things worse."

The frontpage headline of the June 22 edition of The Downey Patriot asked, "Is Downey Ready for Pot?" To this, one should reasonably answer, "Downey was born ready!"

Downey already has lengthy experience with liquor sales, abortion clinics, oversized residential and commercial construction, tattoo shops, Section 8 housing, and drug rehab services. New frontiers are a part of Downey's natural progression, so it is not entirely unexpected or unreasonable to hear that it could officially move toward free syringes, bikini bars, pawn shops, pot dispensaries, strip clubs, swingers' clubs, and the Church of Satan.

Thank goodness Downey's sisterhood with the Irish County of Roscommon can guide us through.

DOWNEY _ Downey's Fiscal Year 2023-24 budget will put special emphasis on maintaining quality of services for residents, while still spending over 60 percent of its budget on public safety.

The Downey City Council approved its eleventh consecutive – and first for new City Manager Roger Bradley - balanced budget for fiscal year 2023-24 on Tuesday, projecting \$115,000,000 in general fund expenditures.

The city is also conservatively predicting \$118,188,000 in general fund revenues.

The city will add several new full-time equivalent (FTE) personnel in the coming fiscal year, including an economic development director, homelessness solutions manager, associate traffic engineer, citywide systems engineer, two building inspectors, a plan checker, senior code enforcement officer, two part time code enforcement officers, a fire inspector, and a crime analyst.

Mayor Claudia M. Frometa emphasized that these additions were necessary to meet the five areas of priority that the council had determined in recent budget discussions and goal workshops, those being fiscal responsibility, efficiency and adaptability, economic vibrancy, quality of life, safety, and infrastructure, and public engagement.

"These are truly necessary because the departments that we have currently have been significantly understaffed, and we really are trying to, not just accommodate for growth in our community, but also the services and the expediency of which we are tackling the requests coming In Downey to us," said Frometa.

Bradley made note that many of these additions are funded be 14 non-profit organizations through grants or are "budget neutral.²

Downey Police and Fire Departments will receive a vast majority of expenditures, \$43,668,000 and \$27,632,000 respectively; 62 percent of the general fund allotments, and an increase of around 5 percent from last year.

The city will next spend most on community enhancement, comprising the Community Development and Public Works departments, allotting over \$14.7 million.

Quality of life (Parks and at 8008 Firestone Blvd., in the Recreation, library) will receive over \$11.3 million (10 percent) of the budget.

There will be an increase of \$2.3 million spending in general government, \$11.6 million overall. This includes the upcoming special elections, and a \$296,000 increase for SEAACA services.

Assuming that these projections prove correct and accurate, it is predicted that the city will end the fiscal year with just under a \$3.1 million surplus, and a total general fund reserve total of \$33,748,000.
